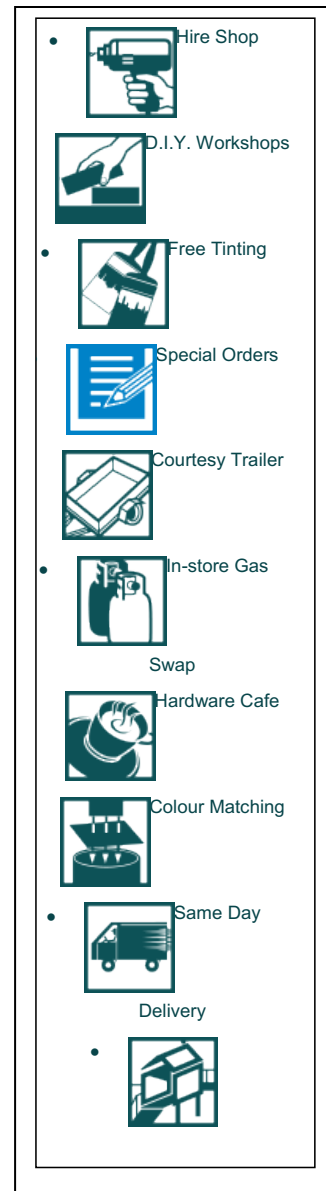

6. **Questions that may be asked by students** (10 minutes)
