HEALTH AND SAFETY:

- Pre-visit 'Health and Safety' training to be provided to the group by Safety Systems (Paul Flood)
- Workplace Safety expectations on arrival
- Sign in is not required.
- Risk Assessment – completed by school
 - Students need to be reminded to 'hug the walls' and be mindful of obstacles such as bed trolleys and wheelchairs
 - Privacy and Confidentiality requirements – Students cannot discuss who they saw at the hospital and photos are only to be taken by the teacher. Patients, visitors or staff cannot be in the background. Please be aware of privacy and confidentiality of patients and staff within the hospital.
 - Hair nets will be required in the kitchen area.
 - Mini buses can drop off and pick up at the main entrance of the hospital. Coaches can double park on Lily Street. Volunteers can assist inside the hospital if required.
- All visitors must be in good health, with no obvious colds / flu, infections, or have suffered from gastro / vomiting in the previous 48 hours.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:

- All students to be in full school uniform. Highly visible vest are not required.
- Hair nets will be required in kitchen. These will be provided by the venue.
- Students to have solid shoes prior to entering the hospital.

SCOPE OF VISIT:

The visit is to provide three groups of Grade 6 students (approx. 16 per group) with an understanding of the ranges of services, jobs, skills and pathways at the workplace.
